Pre-registration

How to get there?

How to get to Tampere by air?

Tampere is easily accessible by air via its European route network with airBaltic, Finnair and Ryanair. Tampere is a Home City to airBaltic and there is excellent global connectivity via European hub airports Amsterdam, Copenhagen, Munchen and Riga within airBaltic and its' partner airlines route network.

How to get to Ylöjärvi from Tampere airport?

Tampere airport is 18km or 15 minutes away from the course venue in Ylöjärvi by car. Taxi to Ylöjärvi or Tampere costs about 50€.

How to get to Ylöjärvi from Helsinki airport?

If you do not have a connecting flight to Tampere, there are buses and trains from Helsinki airport to Tampere city. From Tampere city are buses to Ylöjärvi.
