# **TEST FOR DEGREE PROMOTION**

Participants wishing to test for a 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> degree promotion must:

- send the thesis, curriculum and application form through the National/Allied Association at least one (1) month before the promotion date to the ITF HQ.
- pay the examiner grading fee cash one hour prior to the grading.
- bring 5 wooden boards measured 30x30x2 cm (only up to 6<sup>th</sup> degree).
- test for degree promotion will be at the last day of the course and the result shall be given directly after the promotion.
- no spectators are allowed during the degree promotion.
- the candidate might be accompanied by his instructor.

# TRAINING PROCEDURE

The OC informs the participants about the following before Opening Procedure:

- participants must wear a clean and ironed official ITF Dobock at all time.
- before each new session participants line up in order to welcome the Instructors.
- after each session participants remain until the Instructors leave the venue.
- participants must act according to the official ITF protocol.
- participants standing at ease must assume ready stance with their hands behind the back at all times.
- participants sitting at ease must cross their legs at all times.
- participants allowed to ask questions shall stand up at all times and assume ready stance with their hands behind the back.
- participants before asking a question shall first announce their name and country.
- transportation (if necessary) ready for the committee right away after the session.

# CLOSING PROCEDURE (right after the last training session)

- questionnaire given to the participants (15 minutes )
- closing ceremony by the OC.
- closing of the IIC by the Chairman
- group photo session
- individual photo session with the Instructors organized by the OC will take place after the last IIC training session
- signatures to be given by Instructors at the table those interested to make one line.
- the OC accompanies the Instructors out of the venue.



### **Public Transport:**



If you have a smartphone you can use the ZVV and or SBB app, this is also a recommendation if you want to go to the City of Zuerich or you can use <u>www.zvv.ch</u>. Zurich is one of the best developed area with public transport, they are many ways to travel to our venue.

### From the Airport:

There are around 8 Bus Lines which drive to the center of Kloten (Line 520/521/530731/732/734/765)

# From the City of Zürich via Train or Tram or Bus:

The easiest way to come to our venue is form the Zurich Train Main Station via Zurich Airport and then use one of the Bus Lines above





# By Car (not recommended, traffic jam and not enough parking areas):
