

Weigh In

The Weigh In for all participants shall take place on Wednesday June 15, 2022 from 14.00, according to the weigh-in schedule, in the Sports Hall located inside the village

Please note!

Competitors must make the weigh in wearing their ITF approved dobok trousers and T-shirt or Polo shirt. A maximum of 500 grams margin over the indicated weight category is permitted. Competitors not making their weight at the 1st attempt will have one (1) hour to present themselves for the 2nd and last attempt. If he/she doesn't make the weight then he/she shall be removed from the sparring competition category and shall not be allowed to enter any other weight category.

















ENTRY FEES

Individual entry fee is € 80,00 per competitor, (individual and/or team member).

Team entry fee is € 50,00 per team.

Pre-Arranged Sparring entry fee is € 50,00 per team.

No refunds will be given for any reason even if a competitor or team is disqualified.

The Open European Cup competitor's entry fees may be transferred electronically and must by cleared by May 15, 2022 to the AETF Bank Account or paid by cash at arrival directly to the AETF registration point at the reception building.

Competitors shall compete in the divisions laid down in the following rules, but all competitors must be healthy and registered with their National Associations or their own School.

Only clubs/schools that have a valid ITF plaque certificate, and/or national teams, representing countries that have paid the annual fee to the AETF, may take part in the European Cup.

Individual Pattern and Sparring

Male/Female - Individual/Team
The pyramid system of elimination will be used.

PATTERN

Competitors will compete 1 to 1 and will perform simultaneously one (1) designated Pattern.

In the semi-finals and finals there will be two (2) designated Patterns (one from the last three patterns, and one from all the others patterns).

The Judges will choose the best competitor to go forward to the next round.

Blue and red belts (one category) compete with designated Pattern being any one from:

- a) CHON-JI to JOONG-GUN in case of 4. Gup
- b) CHON-JI to TOI-GYE in case of 3. Gup
- c) CHON-JI to HWA-RANG in case of 2. Gup
- d) CHON-JI to CHOONG-MOO in case of 1. Gup

Black Belts compete with designated Pattern being any one:

- a) 1st degree from CHON-JI to GE-BAEK
- b) 2nd degree from CHON-JI to JUCHE.
- c) 3rd degree from CHON-JI to CHOI-YONG.
- d) 4th, 5th and 6th degree from CHON-JI to MOON-MOO.
- e) (Masters) 7th and 8th degree compete with the designates 5th-6th degreee patterns

In individual sparring competitors shall participate in the category according to their weight.

It is not allowed to participate in any other weight class.

The competitors of age 18-21 years, have the choice to compete between youth and senior categories, but cannot compete in both age categories.

DURATION OF BOUTS & DECISIONS

Individual elimination and final bouts will be for:

All Blue/Red Belts categories:

• one (1) rounds of two (2) minutes;

All Black Belts categories:

• two (2) rounds of two (2) minutes with a one-minute break between rounds.

















Team Pattern and Sparring

The pyramid system of elimination will be used. Team match is divided into:

- Pattern Male or Female or Mixed
- Sparring Male or Female (in sparring competitors may be of any weight)
- Each team may perform in Pattern and/or Sparring

COMPETITORS NUMBER

TEAM PATTERNS (Male and/or Female)

Teams may consist of Male, Female or Mixed Team with a maximum of five (5) competitors and one (1) optional reserve.

TEAM SPARRING (Male or Female)

Teams may consist of a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) competitors and one (1) optional reserve.

Changes of the team competitors are not allowed once they have been indicated for the various team events.

ELIMINATIONS, PERFORMANCE AND DECISIONS

Both teams shall perform one (1) Optional Pattern, beginning from the semi-finals one (1) designated and one (1) Optional Pattern.

The judges will choose the better one to go forward to the next round.

In case of a draw a designated pattern, from all the remaining patterns, shall be drawn from a basket or electronically and must be performed until the winner is decided.

Team Colour Belts

The optional pattern being any from CHON-JI to the pattern defined by the individual pattern categories mentioned, according to the lowest belt level in the team

Team Black Belts

The optional pattern being any from CHON-JI to GE-BAEK

Competitors may line up in any format they choose and team members may perform movements individually, or together, as they choose, but as teamwork (for example: one team member may not perform moves of the pattern on his own without the other team members following in unison).

















JUNIOR AND SENIOR TEAM SPARRING

Each Sparring Team (Male or Female of any degree and weight) must consist of a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) competitors and one (1) reserve (optional). Each team bout will be one (1) round of two (2) minutes.

ATTENTION!

In according to the AETF European Cup Tournament Rules in team matches the following decision will apply "The old rules of team sparring".

When three (3) or four (4) corner referees give a decision in favour of one competitor then that competitor is the winner and two (2) points will be added to the team score.

When three (3) or four (4) corner referees decide that it is a draw then one (1) point will be added to each team score.

When two (2) corner referees give a decision in favour of one competitor (two (2) for one competitor + one (1) for the other + one (1) given it as a draw or two (2) giving it as a draw) then that competitor who got the decision of the two (2) corner referees is the winner and two (2) points will be added to the team score.

When two (2) corner referees give a decision in favour of one competitor and the other two (2) corner referees give a decision in favour of the other competitor then the result will be a draw and one (1) point will be added to each team score.

When all five (5) bouts are finished and the result is a draw then each coach will select one (1) competitor to spar an extra bout of two (2) minutes. The team whose competitor wins this bout will be the winner.

If at this time it results in a further draw then the first scored point will decide who the winner is.

When two (2) corner referees give a decision in favour of one competitor in case of the first scored point bout then that competitor is the winner.

















Pre-Arranged Sparring

Pre-arranged sparring event is only for black belts. All age categories.

Male, Female and/or Mixed Couples,

Pre-arranged sparring events will be decided by the pyramid tournament system.

The competition will take place following the ITF competition rules.

Competitors, while competing must wear the "OFFICIAL APPROVED" TKD dobok with badges officially approved by the ITF.

The black belt must be of the official dimensions and must indicate the competitor's degree.

Female competitors may wear a white T-shirt under the dobok jacket.

It is NOT obligatory to have the name of the country on the back of the dobok.

It is ALLOWED to have one (1) club logo on the dobok.

Sponsorship is allowed on the left dobok jacket sleeve measuring 5 x 8 cm.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND PROTECTIVE WEAR

Competitors must wear:

- Red or blue colour hand and feet safety equipment of an approved type
- Groin guards must be worn inside the dobok trousers (male only)
- Red or blue colour safety helmet of an approved model
- Mouth guards being of a transparent colour

















Competitors may, optionally, wear the following:

- Shin protectors.
- Breast protectors must be worn INSIDE the dobok jacket (female only).
- Groin guards must be worn INSIDE the dobok trousers (female only).
- These all being of an approved type consisting of elasticized material with sponge or rubber type padding and containing no metal, bone or hard plastic or similar hard material whatsoever, nor involving the use of zip, lace or stud fasteners.

Other:

- No other protective or safety equipment may be worn, except in special circumstances with the approval of the Tournament Committee.
- All competitors with injuries which require bandaging or strapping of any kind must request and obtain the medical form from the AETF Tournament and Umpire Committee.
- No jewellery, watches or other adomments may be worn, hair may be kept in place using a material of a soft elastic nature only, no grips or slides are allowed.

EQUIPMENTCHECK

Competitors' dobok and/or equipment check will take place outside of the square to ensure that they are of an officially approved type and that they are not defective. Should any item(s) not be satisfactory then they must be changed. The competitor/team has a maximum of three (3) minutes to change what is requested, following which they will be disqualified and the match points awarded to the opponent where appropriate.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

It will be announced in which square an event will take place and it is the responsibility of the competitors/teams to be close to the square so that they may compete without delay when called upon to do so.

Competitors will be called to the red or blue side of the square complete with any equipment (such as safety equipment) which they require. Should they not come forward immediately then their name and/or country will be called for a second time. Should the individual/team still not come forward to the square within one (1) minute from the second call then they will be disqualified.

















INJURY LIABILITY AND INSURANCE - COMPETITORS

All competitors must be in possession of insurance coverage as the host is not responsible for any eventuality and/or injury



DISPUTE PROCEDURE

Only the Coach can present a protest when a decision seems to violate the rules. Each protest must be written in the English language on the official protest form and presented to the Chairman of the Umpire Committee within five (5) minutes from the end of the match.

The protest must be precise and circumstantial and must be accompanied by a fee of € 100,00 fixed by the Tournament Committee, in order to limit such protests to cases where decisions are really questionable.

Only in cases where the Umpire Committee positively accepts the protest the fee will be returned to the coach. In case of a protest, the winner cannot compete again before the decision of the Umpire Committee has been made.

COACHES

For individual or team competition there will be only one (1) coach close to the square.

During the tournament, coaches must wear a training suit, gymnastic shoes and carry a towel.

They will be seated at least one (1) meter away from the square.

They must not interfere in the competition by action or words.

They are the only ones allowed to present an official protest.

Failure to abide by the above mentioned rules may render the coach liable to be disqualified from his advisory position.

















UMPIRES

Officials will wear the dress requirements as laid down in the ITF Umpires rules.

The Organizing Committee will cover full board accommodation for 5 days / 4 nights from Wednesday June 15, 2022 to Sunday June 19, 2022. All selected Umpires must arrive at Bella Italia Village within 15.00 hrs of Wednesday June 15,2022.

Clubs/Schools/Teams must complete their Open European Cup 2022 Umpire Application form, available under the link https://forms.gle/baofrmdLwG5AUtYV8 on or before April 17, 2022 in order to be accepted as Umpire for the European Cup 2022.

The AETF T&U Committee shall provide the Umpire rooming list to FITAE-ITF based on twin or triple rooms on or before May 15th, 2022 who shall then take care of the required hotel accommodation for maximum of 50 Umpires.

SUPPORTERS

Supporters wishing to obtain the competition ID Card must register through their delegation.

The Delegation responsible registers the supporters in the Sportdata web application.

However, supporters NOT booking their accommodation through the organiser shall pay € 10,00 per person per day for entry to the village and access to the Palasport (or € 20.00 if they wish to have a self-service lunch). Payment must be made directly at the Bella Italia EFA Village reception. Access to the Village does not entitle you to any other services (beach service, outdoor swimming pools, water park, etc.).

PRESS AND PHOTOGRAPHY

The organizers have their own staff for photography and reporting, so no movement of persons with cameras will be allowed in the competition area.

1st, 2nd and two (2) 3rd place winners are awarded with medals.

Overall European Cup junior club/school winner. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners are awarded with a trophy.

Overall European Cup senior club/school winner. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners are awarded with a trophy.

Overall European Cup junior and senior club/school winner. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners are awarded with a trophy.

In order to obtain the Championships ID card all clubs/schools must apply for the hotel accommodation through Fitae-Itf

Participants may choose any other accommodation outside the village.

Lignano Sabbiadoro is situated along the coast of the Northern Adriatic Sea, halfway between Venice and Trieste.


Traveling to Lignano by air

Lignano is about one hour's drive from the international airports of Venice Marco Polo, Trieste Ronchi dei Legionari and Treviso Canova. These airports are all connected to the beach by a regular train and bus service.

Trieste Airport - Ronchi dei Legionari

Situated 65 km from Lignano Sabbiadoro, Trieste-Ronchi dei Legionari airport was recently upgraded with a new railway connection to the Milano-Venezia-Trieste line.

The airport offers 11 flight routes with destinations in Italy, Great Britain, Germany and Spain offered by eight airlines.




















Venice Airport - Marco Polo

Situated 95 km from Lignano Sabbiadoro, Venice Marco Polo airport is one of Italy's leading airports offering flights to major European and international destinations.

From the airport, you can travel to Lignano Sabbiadoro by:

- taxi and private transfers,
- bus with a direct Express bus





Traveling to Lignano by train

The Milano-Trieste railway line passes about 20 km from Lignano Sabbiadoro.

Latisana-Lignano-Bibione is the nearest train station for the seaside resorts. The nearest train stations to Lignano Sabbiadoro:

Latisana-Lignano-Bibione station, 23 km;

Udine station, 60 km – Bus connection to Lignano Portogruaro;

Caorle station, 35 km.

There is a regular daily bus service from each station to the nearby seaside towns, including Lignano Sabbiadoro.

Traveling to Lignano by car

Take the A4 Venezia – Trieste motorway or the A23 Tarvisio - Venezia and exit at the Latisana tollbooth, continue along the SS 354 road towards Lignano for about 18 km.

The A4 and A23 motorways are linked to the main Italian and European motorway intersections.





















Traveling to Lignano by bus

A regular bus service links Lignano Sabbiadoro with major cities in Italy and abroad.

The local transport company TPL FVG runs a town (in summer) and out-of-town service. The out-of-town routes connect Lignano Sabbiadoro with the main inland towns and with Udine.

The ATVO bus service also operates in the area with connections to the nearby Veneto region and airports.

Traveling to Lignano by taxi and transfer

Local taxi and transfer companies offer transport to and from the main airports, train stations and tourist attractions.
